Our tournament includes divisions for recreational and high-performance sparring and poomsae, sanctioned by the Alberta Taekwondo Association. Officiating will be led by national and international Canadian referees. All sparring matches will incorporate new World Taekwondo rules (September I, 2022), using the best of 3 system. Recreational fighters are guaranteed two matches. Sanctioned black belt divisions will be using KPNP Electronic scoring equipment in a single elimination format.

Having had the opportunity to travel over the summer with Olympian, Sayed Najem, it was fantastic to see so much optimism from Taekwondo Masters across Alberta. Momentum is picking up post-covid and we hope our tournament will provide an exciting competition experience for all.




#### **Poomsae Events**

- Recreational Poomsae Individual
  - All belt levels, all ages
  - o Competitor performs one poomsae according to belt level
  - O Uniform is any style white Taekwondo dobok, appropriate belt, bare feet
- Black Belt Sport Poomsae World Taekwondo poomsae rules (May 14, 2019)
  - o Recognized poomsae draws will be published by November 24
    - Categories
      - Individual: Youth, Cadet, Junior, U30, U40, U50, U60, U65, O65
      - Teams and Pairs: Youth, Cadet, Junior, U30, O30
  - o Free Style poomsae competitors must provide music on a USB memory device
    - Categories
      - Individual and Pairs: U17, O17
      - Mixed Team: 12+
- Pairs must consist of one male and one female competitor
- Teams consist of three competitors of the same gender
- Categories are based on the year of birth of the competitor

Youth	born in 2011 and later	U40	born in 1982-1991
Cadet	born in 2008-2010	U50	born in 1972-1981
Junior	born in 2005-2007	U60	born in 1962-1971
U30	born in 1992-2004	U65	born in 1957-1961

## Sparring Events - Current WT Rules (September 1, 2022) - Best of 3 System

- Recreational Sparring Divisions Competitors Guaranteed Two Matches
  - Colour Belt Sparring
    - All ages, all belt levels
    - NO head contact allowed
  - Black Belt Recreational Sparring
    - All ages
    - NO head contact in youth divisions
    - Head contact optional in cadet, junior, and senior divisions
  - o Mandatory equipment to be supplied by the competitor
    - Head and chest protector, groin guard, mouth guard, shin and arm pads
    - Any style white Taekwondo dobok and appropriate belt
- Sanctioned Black Belt Sparring Single Elimination Format
  - Weigh-ins Competitors must meet the weight category in which they register
    - Friday 7:00-9:00 PM at Whitecourt Taekwondo Dojang 4105-41 Ave
    - Saturday 12:00-1:00 PM at Allan and Jean Millar Centre
  - Mandatory equipment to be supplied by the competitor
    - Groin guard, mouth guard, gloves, shin and arm pads
    - Any style white Taekwondo dobok and appropriate belt
    - KPNP Socks available from <u>Captain Sports</u>
  - o Sanctioned black belt fighters may register in both sanctioned and recreational divisions
