- **Provincial Referee Practice Class (P4) – Volunteer Purple Tie Referee**
 - At least 11 years of age
 - At least blue belt (4th Geup)
 - Must be an active Taekwondo student
- **Provincial Referee 3rd Class (P3)**
 - At least 15 years of age
 - At least red stripe (3rd Geup)
 - Must be an active Taekwondo student
- **Provincial Referee 2nd and 1st Classes (P2, P1)**
