Registration Procedure

Registration & Eligibility

Please read the following guidelines carefully. To maintain the **integrity, professionalism, and safety** of all stakeholders, strict adherence to these procedures is required before and during the tournament.

Registration Process

- **How to Register:** Please use the provided link or QR codes to register via the DojangPro online form
- **Data Accuracy:** It is critical that athlete information is accurate, specifically **weight (kg), height (cm), belt level, and Poomsae level**. This ensures fair and safe bracketing for all competitors.

Competitor & Coach Eligibility

- **Membership Requirements:** All Canadian athletes and coaches must be active members of their respective Provincial organization.
- **Alberta Taekwondo Membership:** This membership is mandatory as it provides essential liability insurance, protecting athletes throughout the tournament season and ensuring access to medical treatment if necessary.
- **Coaching Staff:** (1) Head master and up the (3) coaches per dojang. Additional coaches \$50 fee per person.

Payment Information

- **Methods:** Payment must be completed via **E-transfer** prior to the event or in-person at **Chan Lee Taekwondo**.
- **Tournament Fees:**
 - One Event: **\$100.00** / Two Events: **\$110.00** / Three Events: **\$120.00**
- **Day of Registration Payment:** Registration fee paid on the day of the tournament are **ONLY** accepted if the Club Head Master or Coach contacts the host in advance to arrange full payment for all club participants at check-ins.
- **Entrance Fee:** \$10/person 6 years and under free

Competition Schedule

While we strive for absolute punctuality, the schedule is subject to change based on the flow of competition. Athletes must be in the staging area when their division is called. Absence at the time of competition will result in disqualification.

Black Belt Sport Poomsae – WT Poomsae Competition Rules

- Individual Sport Poomsae shall be cut-off system.
- Poomsae draws will be done at the ring.
- Recognized poomsae
 - Individual: Youth*, Cadet, Junior, U30, U40, U50, U60, U65, O65
 - Teams and Pairs: Youth, Cadet, Junior, U30, O30
 - Pairs consist of one male and one female competitor
 - Teams consist of three competitors of the same gender
 - Freestyle (music must be provided on a USB stick in an mp3 format)
- Youth recognized poomsae from Taeguk 4 to Koryo
- Black Belt poomsae competitors have to clearly state Recreational or Sport Poomsae, NOT BOTH.
- Competition Year 2026 Black Belt Sport Poomsae Divisions Categories are based on the year in which the contestant was born.

Competition Standards

- **Rules:** The latest published **WT Competition Rules and Interpretation** will be strictly applied.
- **Format: Single Elimination** for all divisions.
- **Match System:** All matches will follow the **Best of 3** system.

Color Belt Sparring

- **Eligibility:** All ages and all belt levels (adjacent weight classes may be combined).
- **Head Contact: STRICTLY NO HEAD CONTACT.**
- **Match Duration:** 1-minute rounds with a 30-second break between rounds.

Black Belt Recreational Sparring

- **Eligibility:** This competition is specifically designed for **Recreational Black Belts** and is not intended for High-Performance athletes.
 - **Criteria:** Athletes who have previously competed in National or International full-contact Black Belt events are **not eligible**.
 - **Local Experience:** Athletes who have only competed in local-level full-contact events are welcome.

Our Mission: The goal of this event is to foster interest and provide a supportive environment for Black Belts transitioning into full-contact sparring. We aim to ensure every competitor gains a positive, constructive experience.

Coach & Master Collaboration

When filling out the registration form, athletes are asked to fill in their competition experience. We will also notify masters if we have trouble seeking competitors in the same divisions. So please encourage your athletes to try! We will help you make the experience positive and fun.

Black Belt Recreational Sparring Divisions

- All ages (adjacent weight classes may be combined)
- **Weigh-in:** There is no weigh-in required however **ACCURATE** Height (cm) and Weight (kg) required upon registration.
