2026 Canada Nationals

Base Funding:

Top 5 Cadet, Junior, Senior Athletes

$\$500 \times 15 = \7500

Performance funding:

Bronze: \$400

Silver: \$500

Gold: \$600

2026 Canada Open

Special year hosting in AB

- All Athletes who pass the qualification guideline can receive funding
- Basically it aims to pay everyone's registration fee

2026 US Open

Base Funding:

Cadet: \$400

Juniors & Seniors: \$500

$\$2000 + \$5000 = \$7000$

2026 Nationals Criteria for funding

Base Funding

1. **Base funding (BF)** to top 5 AB ranked athletes.
2. Ranking points will include upcoming 2025 K.H.Min, Calgary Open, and Whitecourt sanctioned tournament scheduled.
3. **Ranking will not be updated if athlete(s) are not registered ATA member at each sanctioned events.**
4. If there are unclaimed spots due to higher ranked athletes not participating, lower-ranked athletes can fill the remaining funded spots. **However, ATA need to be notified in advance before submission of funding to AGLC**
5. Selected athletes must request funding
6. Funding will be distributed proven the athletes has passed the weigh-in and appears in the fight tree

Performance Funding

1. **Performance funding (PF):** can be rewarded to all athletes who attend Nationals and are ATA black belt members regardless of ranking status.
2. **Criteria to determine the PF**
 - must be ATA member
 - Have competed in AB sanctioned event
 - Is in AB ranking pool
 - **Won a match that has 5 or more athletes in the division at Canadian Nationals**
3. Bronze \$400, Silver \$500, Gold \$600

2026 Canada Open Funding Criteria

- Our goal is to fund all AB Athletes who attend the Canada Open, their registration fee (\$150 USD = \$200-\$215 Canadian)
- Qualification:
 - Must be ATA black belt member
 - Compete 2 out of 3 AB Sanctioned tournament by December 2025
 - Compete in 2025 Canadian Nationals in Halifax (this gives evidence that they are in HP realm)
- Performance funding:
 - Applies with same criteria as 2025 Nationals: Bronze \$400 Silver \$500 Gold \$600

2026 US OPEN:

- Follows same guideline as 2026 Nationals funding
- Only Difference:
 - Cadets BF: \$400
 - Junior & Senior BF: \$500
- PF: same

Coaches funding for 2026 Canadian Nationals & US OPEN

MAX 2 PC coaches

- BF: \$700
- PF: \$250 Addition if athlete medal

MAX 2 DC Coaches

- BF: \$500
- PF: \$200 Addition if athlete medal

Funding Criteria:

- Selected coaches must be able to coach seniors, juniors, cadets if requested by their personal coach
- Approval of funding will be determined in order of following criteria:
 1. Level of certification: PC > DC level, coaches must be in good standing (COC, TKDCAN, ATA)
 2. Number of ranked athletes at top 5 (top 10 if its necessary to look further)
 3. Current event result
 5. Number of athletes at the event and/or previous year event attendance & results.

2026 Canada Open Coach Funding:

Registration fee + Performance Funding

- **Max ten (10) AB Kyorugi coaches paid registration fee**
- **Additional performance funding to max 5 coaches when athlete podium.**
- **PF will be \$500 regardless of color of medal (athlete must be in a division with 5 or more athletes, won a match to podium)**
- **Coach Selection Criteria as follows:**
 - Selected coaches must be able to coach seniors, juniors, cadets if requested by their personal coach
 - Approval of funding will be determined in order of following criteria:
 1. Level of certification: PC > DC level, coaches must be in good standing (COC, TKDCAN, ATA)
 2. Number of ranked athletes at top 5 (top 10 if its necessary to look further)
 3. Current event result
 5. Number of athletes at the event and/or previous year event attendance & results.
